Feel free to keep doing this as we get out in the sun this spring. We will be rescheduling the neighborhood clean-up for a later date.

March HPCA Meeting Recap

The meeting was called to order by **President Chris Delphin** at 7:10. The speaker who had been lined up for this meeting will now come to the April meeting. A small talk about the Census was given. It is very important to sign up for the Census. The Census is used to determine how much funding and representation should be distributed to communities. After the 2010 Census, we missed out on over \$10,000 per person not listed on the Census. There are 9 questions to answer and it can be filled out online, by phone or by mail. An invitation will go out on March 12. Census Day is April 1. In May, people will start knocking on doors. If you have already filled out and returned your census, you will not be bothered. So, fill out your Census and return it! The Census ends July 31.

At the April 7th meeting, **Abbie Kamin** (Council Member from District C) will be present along with Melissa Allala who will speak about the Census. This will be a great opportunity for Ms Kamin to address our traffic and crime issues. **Editor's note: Ms. Kamin is now scheduled to present in September.**

On May 5, **Catherine Fraser**, a Clean Air Associate with Environment Texas will be our Speaker.

Deed Restrictions - the committee is addressing a situation where a lot has been bought and the owner wants to subdivide the lot.

Membership - As a result of the Face Book membership drive, we have 4 new members bringing our total to 69. Happy Hour will be at Postino's on March 19 at 6:00.

Citizens on Patrol - **Cliff Jones** handed out forms for future and current members of this committee to fill out and return. This will update current members information and add new members to the Citizens on Patrol.

Lamar Park - Clean up effort was generously led by **Mike McMann** on Sunday, February 23rd at the small triangle area on Waugh where Hyde Park signage sits near Legacy Healthcare Facility. Shrubs were cut back and debris removed. Signage can now be read from passing cars. Huge thanks to Mike! It was discussed about reaching out to Legacy to ask if they have an interest in maintaining this small area along with their regular property maintenance. **Melissa Zarikian** is working to schedule a meeting with Houston Parks board Member **Tom Gall** to discuss community needs on improving the park. The park has been speaking with an area tree company to get a sense of the current health of existing trees and the extent to which they need to be pruned.

Treasurer's Report -We have a balance of \$10,386.46. We had revenues of \$1,950.12 and expenses of \$1,237.40.

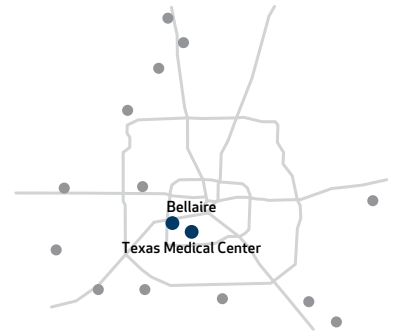

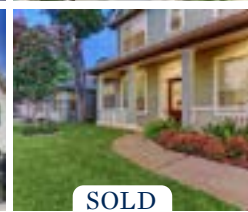

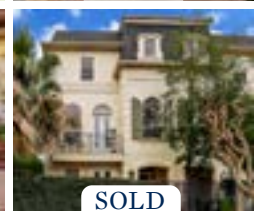
