## Letter from the President



Howdy Hyde Park,

As the City of Houston moves toward “re-opening”, and our neighborhood starts to receive an increasing number of visitors to our area businesses, parks and museums, I hope that you all continue to be safe and heed the guidelines on social distances and wearing a face mask.

## General Meetings

We did not conduct our May general meeting and will not meet in June. With bars limited to 25% capacity, and the likely low turn-out for a meeting, we do not think it is prudent to hold an in-person meeting. We skip a monthly meeting in July, so I think we should be able to meet in August if we continue to make progress as a community.

## What's Going On

Mayor Sylvester Turner has encouraged all Houstonians (symptomatic and asymptomatic) to get tested for COVID-19. The Mayor has also issued his formal request to Tx-DOT for significant modifications to the North Houston Highway Improvement Project (aka the I-45 expansion), calling the project “a once-in-a-generation investment that will shape the City of Houston for decades to come”. 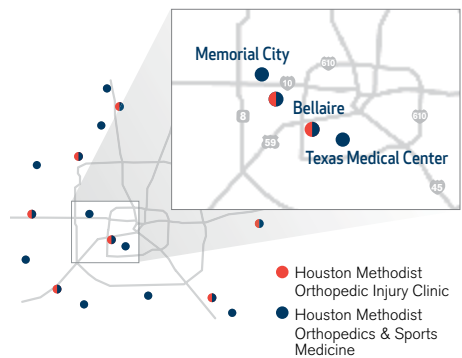

*Eleanor Tinsley Park was named in honor of Eleanor Whilden Tinsley (October 31, 1926 – February 10, 2009), a school board member (1969-1973) and city council member (1979-1995). Tinsley was active in school integration while serving on the Houston Independent School Board. As a councilmember, she worked on regulations to limit billboards, indoor smoking bans, bicycle helmet regulations, gay rights and establishing the 9-1-1 system.*

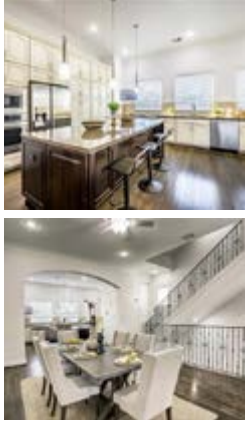

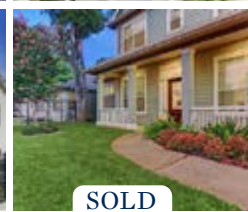

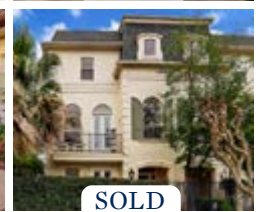
